Title: Garden Birds

Activities

1. Listen to the birds in your garden in the morning or late evening. I have attached a recordings of common garden birds. Click on the hyperlink: <u>https://greennews.ie/know-your-birdsong-click-through-our-quick-guide-to-the-calls-of-common-irish-birds</u> and listen to the song of each bird on the recording and then listen to your garden birds again. Can you identify the birds by their songs?

2. Use the attached garden bird material to help identify birds by their colouring.

Use the Bird Sighting Bar Graph to record the birds you see in your garden on one day. Write the day and the date at the top of the graph.

3. Draw a picture of each bird in your copy or on A4 sheets.

4. Do some research to find out about two of the birds in your garden e.g. What does the bird eat? Where does the bird nest? How many eggs does the bird lay? Do the male and females look different? What is the bird's usual lifespan?

5. Record your findings in your copy.

6. Write a 5 Question Quiz and the answers.
