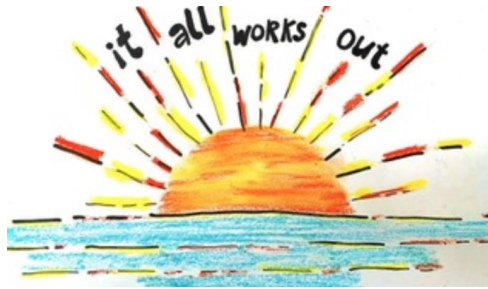


## It All Works Out!
