Covid 19:

We remind our pupils regularly of the need for good hand hygiene and proper respiratory etiquette. Latest H.S.E. guidelines: if your child tests positive for Covid – 19, they should stay at home for 3 full days from the day their symptoms started. Your child can return to school once they have not had a high temperature (38 degrees Celsius or over) or other symptoms for 48 hours and it's been 3 days since they first developed symptoms.

Finally, I would like to thank staff, parents and pupils for the warm welcome I have received. I would also like to take this opportunity to thank my predecessor, Brian McGowan, for the immense contribution he made to life here in St. Colmcille's.

Past Pupils/New Pupils:

Good luck to all our 6th class pupils who have just started their secondary school adventure. We wish them every success and they will always be welcome to visit us in St. Colmcille's.

We welcome all our new 3rd class pupils to our team here in the Senior School. We also welcome pupils who have joined our 4th, 5th and 6th classes.

Pupil Personal Accident Insurance:

As mentioned in our email last week, we highly recommend the Allianz Pupil Personal Accident Insurance Scheme. It provides accident cover 24 hours a day, 365 days a year for your child at a **cost of €9**. No form needs to be returned as Allianz will accept payment as registration to the scheme. The e-payment link on Aladdin will remain open until **Friday 22 September 2023**.

Medical Matters:

If there are any medical issues in relation to your child, please inform the class teacher at the earliest opportunity. All healthcare plans to be returned to the office for filing as soon as possible.

<u>Important School Policies:</u> We ask that all parents familiarise themselves with some of our important school policies, which can be found at the front of this year's school journal.

<u>Mobile Phones:</u> The use of mobile phones/phone devices during the school day is prohibited. However, if your son/daughter needs to bring one to school, we ask that you email your permission to the class teacher. Please note the following:

- 1. The mobile phone must be turned off between 8.40 a.m. and 2.30 p.m.
- 2. The phone must be kept in the pupil's bag at all times.

3. If a child is found to be in possession of a phone which is not turned off, the class teacher will contact the child's parents who will be requested to collect the phone from the school office.

<u>Smart Watches/ Wearable Technology:</u> Smart watches/ Fit Bits are not permitted in the school. The rationale for this has been explained clearly to all pupils. If any parent is insistent on their child having access to their smart watch before/ after school, we ask that you ensure they keep devices switched off and in their school bag for the duration of the school day. However, we would strongly encourage pupils to refrain from bringing these devices to school at all.

School Uniform: Full school uniform must be worn three days per week. This includes plain black footwear (including soles and laces) for both boys and girls. On the other two P.E. days, the school tracksuit is worn along with a plain navy polo shirt. Runners should be worn on P.E. days. If a pupil has a sports activity during/ after school on a uniform day, they should bring in their change of clothes and change in their classroom before the activity.

Children are permitted to wear knee length, navy shorts with either the uniform or the tracksuit. The wearing of cycling shorts, GAA shorts, Nike Pros or similar is not allowed.

<u>Uniform Shop:</u> The uniform shop will be open each Thursday. Please refer to the Uniform Sales Information tab which can be found on the Aladdin app.
