There were 32 girls in the classroom. <b>14</b> left to go to a match. There were 18 girls left.	-	$32 - 18 = 14$
<b>27</b> horses were running in a race. 13 didn't finish the race but 14 crossed over the finish line.	+	$13 + 14 = 27$
Sarah baked 42 cookies and her friend, Amy, baked 36 cookies. There were <b>78</b> cookies altogether.	+	$42 + 36 = 78$
There were <b>156</b> beautiful roses in the garden. The wind blew the petals off 63 of the roses so there were only 93 left.	+	$63 + 93 = 156$
A recipe needed <b>9</b> eggs. Afterwards there were 7 left out of a carton of 16.	-	$16 - 7 = 9$
Ella ran 43 miles in a month. Her friend, Sophie, ran <b>61</b> miles in a month. Together they ran 104 miles in a month.	-	$104 - 43 = 61$

Sam spent €97 out of €303 on a new game. He had <b>€206</b> left.	-	<b>€303 - €97 = €206</b>
Louise read 278 pages in her book. She had 176 pages left to read. Her book had a total of <b>454</b> pages.	+	<b>278 + 176 = 454</b>
Adam played in 47 football matches. He played in the same number of hurling matches. Altogether, he played in <b>94</b> matches.	+	<b>47 + 47 = 94</b>
There were 657 children in a school. <b>338</b> of the children were girls. 319 of the children were boys.	-	<b>657 - 319 = 338</b>
